Virginia Commonwealth University May and December Commencement ceremonies Change in assembly, procession, seating and recognition of graduate students

In an effort to simplify the assembly, procession, seating and recognition of graduate students, the Graduate School has outlined the following changes for upcoming universitywide Commencement ceremonies, starting December 2016:

- All master's degree, post-master's certificate and post-baccalaureate graduate certificate candidates
 from all disciplines will assemble, process and sit together at the universitywide commencement
 ceremonies. Therefore, these candidates will not assemble, process or sit with professional or
 bachelor's degree candidates from other schools or colleges. These candidates will be presented to the
 president of the university by the dean of the Graduate School.
- This change will decrease the number of faculty marshals needed from each school. Please review the information chart on Page 2.
- All master's degree and post-baccalaureate certificate candidates will process after the Ph.D. and Ed.D. candidates. A faculty marshal from the Graduate School or a designee will lead these candidates in the processional.
- Ph.D. candidates will continue to be presented to the president by the dean of the Graduate School.
- Starting December 2016, Ed.D. candidates will be presented to the president by the dean of the School of Education.
- Any school without professional or bachelor's degree candidates participating in the ceremony will not be represented by a faculty marshal or banner in the ceremony.
 - This may affect the representation of the Schools of Dentistry, Medicine and Pharmacy at the winter ceremonies as these schools typically do not have professional or bachelor's degree candidates participating in December. Likewise, the respective deans of these schools will not present any candidates to the president. These schools will have full representation at the May Commencement ceremonies. The information chart on Page 2 provides additional details.
 - Please note: If professional or bachelor's degree candidates from Dentistry, Medicine or Pharmacy plan to participate in the December Commencement ceremony, this guideline will not apply and the school with participating candidates will receive full representation at the winter ceremony.
- The order of the conferring of degrees for graduate students will change to the following:
 - For December ceremonies:
 - Doctor of Philosophy candidates Dean, Graduate School
 - Doctor of Education candidates Dean, School of Education
 - Graduate School (all master's degree candidates) Dean, Graduate School
 - School of Allied Health Professions (professional degree candidates only) Dean,
 School of Allied Health Professions
 - For May ceremonies:
 - Doctor of Philosophy candidates Dean, Graduate School
 - Doctor of Education candidates Dean, School of Education
 - Graduate School (all master's degree candidates) Dean, Graduate School
 - School of Allied Health Professions (professional degree candidates only) Dean, School of Allied Health Professions
 - School of Dentistry (professional degree candidates only) Dean, School of Dentistry
 - School of Medicine (professional degree candidates only) Dean, School of Medicine
 - School of Pharmacy (professional degree candidates only) Dean, School of Pharmacy
