

Summer 2024 Thesis or Dissertation (ETD)

& associated additional submission requirements!

Submitting a thesis or dissertation for graduation? If so, the following tasks must be completed by **5:00pm on Friday, August 9, 2024**.

Master's Thesis Requirements:	Steps 1-2 are REQUIRED for graduation.
Doctoral Dissertation Requirements:	Steps 1-3 are all REQUIRED for graduation.

The Graduate School must receive <u>all required materials</u> before your ETD form will be signed and your upload accepted into Scholars Compass. A hold preventing the degree posting and diploma disbursement will be placed if all ETD requirements are not completed by the deadline.

1.) Submit "ETD Approval Form" to the Graduate School for final signature ETD Approval form using DocuSign

- □ All approval signatures, including the School/College dean's and, if applicable, documentation of IRB or IACUC approval number must be entered **PRIOR** to submitting to the Graduate School for the Dean's final approval signature. (Page two at the bottom of the document.)
- 2.) Upload your electronic thesis or dissertation to the Graduate Schools VCU Scholars Compass repository http://scholarscompass.vcu.edu/
 - Naming your ETD: Your last name, an underscore, your first name, an underscore and your degree. (Example: Smith_ John_MS.pdf) NOTE: Hyphens and other symbols are not allowed.
 - Refer to the <u>Thesis & Dissertation manual</u> for instructions on formatting, pagination, and mandatory items to be included.
 - All titles, embargo options, and approval numbers must match what has been approved on the "ETD Approval Form." See the chart below for acceptable formatting options.
